DRUG DEALERS ARRESTED

One adult and one juvenile were arrested during the service of a search warrant at 48 Malden Street, apartment #3 on Thursday.

Albin Hernandez, 26, of Everett and an unnamed juvenile were placed into custody and charged with drug related offenses as a result of an ongoing drug investigation.

As a result of a tip, by a concerned citizen, Everett Police began an investigation into alleged drug dealing on Malden Street. The investigation led to the issuance of a search warrant for the residence at 48 Malden Street.

Officers serving the warrant included plain clothes and uniformed officers. The suspects inside the apartment refused entry and officers forced their way into the apartment with the use of a steal ramming device.

The scene was secured and the suspects were taken into custody without incident. Seized during the execution of the search warrant were: Marijuana; Clonazepam; Crack Cocaine; \$180; scales; baggies; white powder (believed to be used as a cutting agent); and other items consistent with drug distribution.

Hernandez was charged with Possession of Class B Substance with Intent to Distribute and School Zone Violations. He was arraigned at Malden District Court on Friday.

The juvenile was charged with Possession of Class D Substance with Intent to Distribute, Possession of Class C and School Zone Violations. The juvenile was arraigned at the Cambridge Juvenile Session on Friday.
