### DRUG DEALERS ARRESTED

Everett Police armed with a search warrant arrested two suspected drug dealers and seized evidence on Friday October 10<sup>th</sup>.

Arrested from 134 Chelsea St, Apt 54 were Pedro Henriques, 33, and Renildo Cardoso, 29, both of Everett. Police seized approximately 16 grams of cocaine, 39 percocets, 4 vials of Winstrol (a steroid), over \$2500 and drug paraphernalia which include a scale, clear plastic bags and a drug ledger or "cuff sheet".

Members of the Everett Police Department Special Investigation Unit completed the month long investigation which led to the issuance of a search warrant from Malden District Court and subsequent arrests and seizure of evidence.

According to US Immigration and Customs Henriques and Cardoso are in here illegally and Customs has issued a detainer on the defendants.

"The people of Everett should be proud of the officers who work diligently to protect the City" stated Chief Steven Mazzie. "These types of investigations (drug) are long and often complicated, but this outcome (arrests & seizure) shows the dedication and professionalism that Everett Officers bring daily to the job."

They were arraigned in Malden District Court on drug related charges.

The charges are allegations and the defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty.
