B & E SUSPECT ARRESTED

Everett Police arrest a suspected wanted in conjunction with an attempted break into a home on Everett Street today.

Jason Rousseau, 33, of Everett was arrested and charged with Breaking and Entering in the Daytime with Intent to Commit a Felony. Rousseau also had an outstanding warrant for his arrest.

Police responding to a call for a break in progress at an Everett Street residence, observed the kicked in front door, and spoke with the resident who gave them a description of the suspect.

Officer Joseph Gaff, observed a male fitting the description of the suspect, and after a short foot pursuit placed Rousseau in custody. The victim made positive identification of Rousseau as the person who attempted to break into the home.

Rousseau, who is a person of interest in several B&E's in Everett and Malden, will be arraigned Monday in Malden District Court. The other outstanding cases are still under investigation.

All charges are allegations and the defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty.
